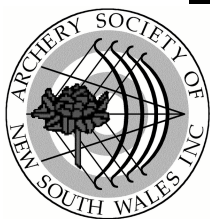


2009 ArcheryNSW STATE AND NATIONAL INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS



EVENT: 18m FITA Indoor (60arrows at 18m) x 2
DATE: 25th and 26th July 2009
VENUE: Cessnock Civic Indoor Sports Centre
Mt View Road Cessnock
ENTRY FEE: \$65.00 (including Judges Levy & \$10 AA entry)
DIVISIONS/ROUNDS: All divisions will be catered for, and shoot an 18m FITA Indoor with compound freestyle scoring inner 10. Crossbows must shoot 3 spot faces to be eligible for records

COMMENCES: Registration / Inspection 8.00 to 8.45, Practice 8.40 to 9.00am,
Scoring commences at 9.00AM

Archers must nominate either a 3 spot or a single (40cm) target face.

NOTE: FAILURE TO NOMINATE A CHOSEN FACE WILL RESULT IN THE ORGANISERS ASSINGING ONE TO SUIT TARGET ALLOCATION AND NO CHANGES CAN BE MADE ON THE DAY.

A double round will be shot. 60 arrows in the morning and 60 in the afternoon 120 arrows in total.

Saturday: Recurve & Longbow will shoot (120 arrows in total) includes Barebow recurve

Sunday: Compound & Crossbow will shoot (120 arrows in total) includes Barebow compound

The standardised practice is to be: 20 min practice - scoring commences straight after practice.

CLOSING DATE: Monday 13/07/09 (postdated this date). No Late entries will be accepted.

AWARDS: Medallions will be awarded at the conclusion of the event for State Indoor. NSW archers will only receive a state medal if participating at the NSW allocated venue. National championships medals will be awarded as follows: Less than 3 entrants: Gold, Only 3 Entrants Gold and Silver, More than 3 entrants Gold, Silver, Bronze.

CLOTHING: ASNSW Tournament Dress Code applies.

GENERAL: Venue has a canteen.

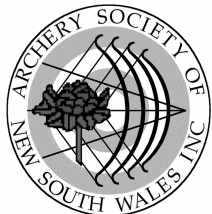

TEAM EVENTS:

RGB Team Event:

An RGB team event will again be run according to 3.3.6.1 in the AA Rules.

3.3.6.1 Teams

Aggregate:

- a) There will be a recurve team and a compound team.
- b) Composition of each team shall be up to four (4) competitors, who may be male or female from any age group.
- c) Only one team in each division of Recurve and Compound shall be entered by each RGB
- d) Teams will compete with the results being the total of the best three (3) scores shot in each division for the event.

AN ADDITIONAL 7 TEAMS EVENTS WILL BE RUN AS WELL AS THE RGB ONE: They will be for:

- Junior: Recurve and Compound
- Open: Recurve, Compound, Barebow (Recurve & longbow combined)
- Master: Recurve and Compound

TEAM REQUIREMENTS:

- There will be three (3) members in a team
- There will be at least one (1) of each gender in a team
- A team name must be submitted
- Team members will be from the same RGB
- An archer may not compete in more than one (1) team (the RGB team event is considered to be a completely separate event) unless entered more than once in the National Championships event in a different category
- No more than one (1) "RGB team" member can be in any one team
- All members of a team will shoot the same bowtype – either recurve or compound
- Team members will be shooting the Indoor Nationals event in the age division compatible with their team entry
 - Junior – all team members to be Junior or less in age and in category entered in event
 - Open – archers from any of the 7 age divisions may be in this team
 - Masters – all team members to be masters or older in age and in category entered in event
- Team winners will be decided on the aggregate of the 3 team members' scores over the 2 rounds (120 arrow/archer).
